On the Road: Seatbelts and Safe Driving Distance

Seatbelt use is mandatory whenever operating or riding in any SDC vehicle or piece of equipment. Buckle up before driving and make sure every passenger is properly restrained. The number of passengers must never exceed the number of seatbelts available. Six seatbelts means six people, four seatbelts means four people. This applies to all occupants, including those in the back seat. Seatbelts save lives, and it is our responsibility to hold ourselves and each other accountable.

Equally important is maintaining a safe following distance. Keep at least three seconds of space between your vehicle and the one ahead, allowing more time in rain, heavy traffic, or low visibility. A safe distance reduces the risk of rear-end collisions and gives you time to react to the unexpected. Stay alert, avoid distractions, and never tailgate.

Even small steps, such as shutting down during breaks or avoiding unnecessary low idle, add up to real savings.

To recognize those making the biggest impact, we will be rewarding top performers in each equipment category. Monthly results highlight operators who achieve the lowest idle times, showing how smart habits in the field directly support the success of our entire team.

Beat the Heat on the Job

- **Drink plenty of fluids:** The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) recommends drinking at least 8 ounces (1 cup) of cool water every 15-20 minutes when working in hot conditions, according to OSHA. Don't wait until you feel thirsty, as thirst is a sign you're already dehydrated.
- Avoid sugary drinks, alcohol, and excessive caffeine: These beverages can dehydrate you further and increase the risk of heat illness. Stick to water or low-sugar electrolyte drinks.

EWRF - ROADWAY



SSDC is proud to support Wharton-Smith on the Eastern Water Reclamation Facility project. Our team is providing a full scope of infrastructure improvements to help deliver this critical utilities facility.

The work includes clearing and grubbing, excavation and embankment, extensive drainage installation, roadway construction, utility improvements and final paving and striping. Key features of the scope also include curb and gutter, sidewalks, signalization, fencing and landscape restoration.

This project highlights SDC's ability to manage large, complex infrastructure projects. The Eastern Water Reclamation Facility will play a vital role in supporting future growth and we are proud to contribute to its successful delivery.



KHovnanian' Homes

CANTER CREEK - Davenport

We are proud to partner with K. Hovnanian Homes on the Canter's Creek residential community. This project represents a major investment in new housing for the region and includes a full scope of site development and infrastructure improvements.

The work spans from 30 acres of clearing and grubbing to pond excavation and grading, 51,000 cubic yards of imported fill and the installation of a complete sanitary sewer system with more than 6,000 linear feet of pipe and a new lift station.

Additional scope includes drainage and stormwater systems, water distribution, roadway construction, sidewalks, curbing and both on-site and off-site paving to connect the community to surrounding roadways.

This is project that underscores SDC's capability to deliver large-scale residential infrastructure. Once complete, Canter's Creek will provide a strong foundation for a thriving new neighborhood of Davenport.SDC is honored to help bring this community to life.

SDC is proud to partner with Hubrich Contracting on the Goodman Road Widening project in Davenport, providing critical roadway and infrastructure improvements to support local access and future growth.

The scope of work includes clearing and grubbing, roadway widening, storm drainage, new curb and gutter, sidewalks, driveway reconstruction, asphalt milling and resurfacing, signage, and pavement markings. This contract is scheduled for completion in 2025.

This important project reflects SDC's continued commitment to delivering high-quality roadway improvements that enhance safety, mobility, and community connectivity across Central Florida.



LENNAR®

Westside Boulevard

SDC is proud to partner with Lennar Homes on the Westside Boulevard Extension in Osceola County. The project combines roadway and utility improvements to support future residential growth.

Work includes 17 acres of clearing and grading, 165,000 cubic yards of fill, storm drainage systems, curbing, sidewalks and more than 20,000 square yards of asphalt paving.

The utility package delivers new sanitary force mains and over 3,000 linear feet of 24" water main, along with valves, fittings and tie-ins to existing systems.

This \$12 million project highlights SDC's ability to deliver large-scale infrastructure that strengthens connectivity in Central Florida.

Elite Estates

Work is underway on the Elite Estates development with Columnar Investments, a large-scale residential project bringing new single-family and multi-family homes to Central Florida, adjacent to Lennar's ED2. The scope of work is extensive, including site clearing and grubbing, pond excavation and embankment, major earthwork with more than 133,000 cubic yards of imported fill and grading for both lots and roadways. SDC is also responsible for full utility installation; sanitary sewer, storm drainage, potable water and reclaimed water systems. We are also installing roadway with curbs, sidewalks, signage and additional improvements to Clay Whaley Road.




