BUILDING A SAFETY CULTURE TOGETHER

Construction is a Team activity

OUR FEATURED PROJECTS

In these unprecedented times of Covid-19, SDC has continued to position itself with new projects and continues to diversify.

INDIGO @ CHAMPIONS RIDGE is a 19 acre site for a repeat client, Faver Gray. They are located in the Four Corners area of US 27 & CR 54. This project started in August and has over 170,000 cubic yards of earthwork, 21,000 square yards of paving & 5,000 linear feet of utilities. Repeat clients, like Faver Gray, come from excellent working relationships the SDC Team has developed at the Rise at MetroWest.

SYCAMORE RESORT HOTEL is a 10 acre site near the attractions that will include the largest exfiltration drainage system ever installed by SDC. The project is scheduled to start in September and will last 6 months.

FEATURED PROJECTS




Construction for the next phase of the **Vehicle Maintenance Facility (VMF)**, owned by Brightline, began in May. SDC is performing drainage, base and paving for Wharton Smith, the General Contractor for this project. This project includes over earthwork, 20,000 cubic yards of muck removal, 8,800 linear feet of storm drainage up to 72" inches in diameter, nearly 13,000 linear feet of rail underdrain and 38,000 square yards of asphalt paving.

Orange County - SDC is currently work on the Fort Christmas Road widening and resurfacing project.

Another Orange County project is the **Gatlin Avenue & Kennedy Avenue**, **Arrow Road** intersection improvement. This project is a 160 day contract scheduled to start in October and will consist of storm drainage, base, paving flatwork and pavement marking.

PUBLIC WORK SPOTLIGHT - SDC is nearing completion of the \$5.5M Seminole County 5-points project and has another Seminole County project projected to start in September. The 5-Point Project is scheduled for completion in October, nearly 6 months ahead of schedule. This is just the beginning of other projects in this area in which SDC will pursue.



Airport Blvd Sidewalk Replacement & Pedestrian Trail This project is located along West Airport Boulevard includes storm drainage, gravity wall and over 2,900 square yards of sidewalk and driveway replacement. In addition to this, the project includes a one span bridge structure over an outfall ditch.

Normandy Off Site Completion August 28, 2020.

We appreciate the effort made by the team working Deltona's Normandy Project. Site Superintendent, Troy McQuiston guided his crew to complete the project by our customer's deadline. Proving to our clients SDC Works! We celebrated the success with a Mission BBQ lunch for those still at the jobsite on Friday, September 4th.


